



IMAGE GUIDELINES

These guidelines apply to images submitted to Winchester Savings Bank for Personalized VISA debit cards. Images containing the following may be rejected by the Bank or its card vendor:

The name, trademark, slogan or any other identifying marks of any other financial institution, bank, or credit union other than Winchester Savings Bank;

The name, trademark, slogan or any other identifying marks of any card company other than VISA (e.g. MasterCard, American Express, Diners Club, Cirrus);

Political statements or symbols;

Trademarks or advertising or promotional material (e.g. slogans, business cards) or branded product names;

Celebrities, musicians, athletes or other public figures;

Phone numbers or Internet or email addresses;

Socially unacceptable groups (e.g. cults, gangs, supremacy organizations);

Nude or semi-nude images;

Provocative or sexual content;

Violence, firearms, weapons, ammunition, alcohol or tobacco;

Profanity or obscenities;

Racially/culturally/gender-insensitive, prejudicial or discriminatory subject matter;

Opinions or beliefs of religious groups;

Illegal or anti-social behavior.

The Bank also may reject any image which may interfere with the security features of the card, that has the potential to reflect negatively on Winchester Savings Bank, or on which someone else holds the copyright, including but not limited to professional photographs or photographs including artwork or other individuals (unless you have written permission from the creator of the professional photograph, the creator of the artwork, or all individuals in the photograph).

The foregoing list is not exclusive, and Winchester Savings Bank and its card vendor retain the right to decide that any submitted image may not be used. For more information, contact the Deposit Operations Department at (781) 729-2130.

UPLOAD GUIDELINES

Image files can be in either .JPEG, .GIF, .PNG, .TIFF or .BMP formats.

The maximum file size is 10 megabytes (MB).

Images must be at least 840 x 840 pixels.

Small images will reproduce poorly when printed.

As you increase the scale of your image too much, it may also print poorly.

The bigger the image you choose, the longer it will take to upload.

The time your image takes to upload depends on your own internet connection speed.

Should your image be slow to upload, please talk to your own internet access provider for help.
