IMPORTANT INFORMATION CONCERNING ATM & DEBIT CARDS AND TRAVEL OUTSIDE THE U.S.

Due to an increase in fraudulent transactions involving ATM and Debit cards occurring outside the United States, Winchester Savings Bank (as well as other banks) may find it necessary, from time-to-time, to block all, or certain types of, ATM and/or Debit Card transactions originating in certain countries. Therefore, whenever you plan to travel outside the United States, we ask you to call us before you leave to see if we have any transaction restrictions in effect for the country(ies) to which you will be traveling. Also, because we may add or remove restrictions at any time, we suggest that you carry alternative payment methods.

CURRENTLY, ALL ATM AND DEBIT CARD TRANSACTIONS ARE BLOCKED IN THESE COUNTRIES:
